Terms and Conditions

OMJ invite you to enter our drawing competition.

By entering this competition, you agree that you have read, understood and agree to be bound by these competition rules.

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to selected UK households of any age. If you are under 18 years old, you must have the consent section of the 'Entry / Consent' form completed. Proof of age and identity may be required.
2. You may submit one entry per person. Illegible, incomplete, defaced entries will not be accepted. We do not accept responsibility for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt. Please note that entries will not be returned.
3. The competition is open as stated in the letter provided to you. A copy of this with the distribution list will be kept on our records. Any entries submitted after this time will not be accepted.

Submitting your entry

4. You can draw your design on paper or design it on a computer. Please do not use photographic images.
5. Your entry must include your design, your name, age, contact details (address and telephone number) and may include some information about the idea behind your design ('your entry'). All this information is requested on the 'Consent / Entry' form that must be submitted with your entry.

Intellectual property rights

7. Your entry must be your own work and must not have been published elsewhere or have won a prize in any other competition. It is your responsibility to ensure that your design does not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws.
8. You warrant to us that your design is your own work and that it does not contain anything that is defamatory, obscene or otherwise offensive.
9. Our right to use your entry includes the right to copy, reproduce, modify, adapt, and otherwise communicate it to the public, including via our website and publicity materials and on Facebook, but for the avoidance of doubt we shall not sell or commercially exploit your entry without your consent.

10. You agree that we may contact you to take part in and cooperate with a reasonable amount of publicity or other promotional activity with us, and agree that we may publish your name and home town name, and any photographs made by us or on our behalf and featuring you and/or your entry.

The winning entry

12. The 'Winner' will be notified by telephone on or before the date advised on the letter provided to you. If there is no answer by phone and no facility to leave a voicemail, the voucher will be hand delivered to the address on the competition entry.
